

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy sets forth the online information practices of Steelman Partners and its affiliated entities (“Steelman”)

Steelman collects two kinds of information from you: personally-identifiable information that you choose to provide to us and non personally-identifiable information, such as your IP address.

Personally-Identifiable Information

The only personally-identifiable information that we collect is what you voluntarily submit to us. For example, if you e-mail questions or requests for information about Steelman or its services, we may request your name, mailing address, telephone number and/or e-mail address in order to respond to your inquiries.

Also, if you submit a resume or application for employment with Steelman via e-mail, you will be required to include personally-identifiable information so that Steelman can adequately review your application and contact you. Steelman may collect and store the information you choose to provide us in order to send you information about Steelman from time to time.

Please be aware that Steelman is not responsible for the privacy practices of any other websites whether linked to the Steelman website or not. We encourage our users to read the privacy statements of each and every website that they visit for more information on how your information may be collected and used.

Non Personally-Identifiable Information

An IP Address is a number used by computers on a network to identify your computer so that data can be transmitted to you. We collect IP Address information in order to administer our website and to gather broad demographic information.

Cookies are pieces of data that a website sends to a user’s computer while the user is viewing the website. Cookies identify your web browser and store information about your visits, but do not reveal any personally-identifiable information about you. We may use cookies to understand what parts of our website users are visiting the most and to help us improve this website.

Information Sharing

We may share personally-identifiable and/or non personally-identifiable information with select third parties, including our agents, affiliates, partners and sponsors. Also, we may disclose personally-identifiable information when required to do so under law or in cooperation with a legal request in connection with any law enforcement investigation or other public safety matter.
